Make a Bowling Pin Set from Recycled Plastic Water Bottles

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Skill Level: Easy

Total Time: 35 + minutes

Materials:

- 10 plastic water bottles, all the same size. Make sure they are dry and empty.
- Felt or fabric totaling about 4 sheets.
- Felt numbers
- Glue (Hot glue or craft glue)
- Hot glue gun
- Scissors

Advice: We did find that the hot glue worked the better then other glue and kept the felt from peeling up.

Instructions:

- 1. Save or collect at least 10 water bottles of the same size. Make sure they are all dry and empty when ready to begin your project.
- 2. Cut 10 strips of felt (or fabric) about 10" long x 2" wide.
- 3. Find something circular about 2" in diameter. Cut around or trace & cut.
- 4. Cut 10 circles.
- 5. Lay out your strips and circles. Come up with the color combinations you like best.
- 6. Place hot glue all around the label and lay the felt strip on top. When you reach the other end, place a small amount of glue on the edge of the top of the felt strip. Cover with the other end of your felt strip and trim off any excess.
- 7. Place felt strips on all 10 water bottles. Make sure to keep your circles matched up with bases you choose for your color combinations.
- 8. Glue on the circles and allow base to dry.
- 9. Cut and glue the numbers on each pin. Once the numbers are dry, find a ball and begin to bowl!
